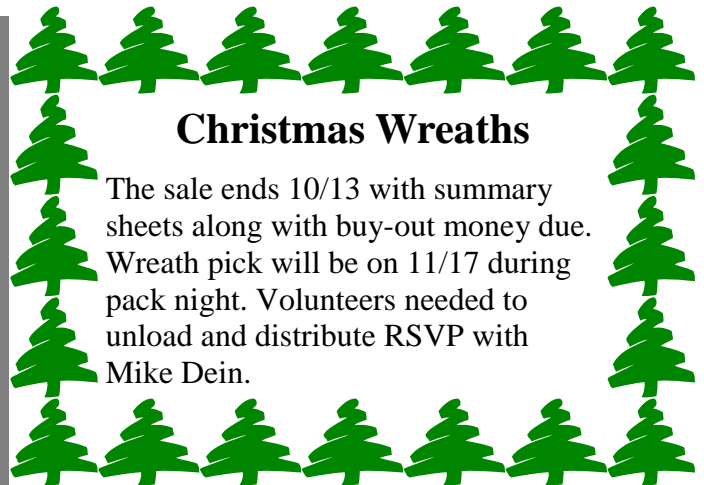

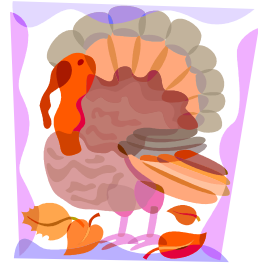
## October Pack Night
